

## **ARCHITECTURE Entrance Exam**

ARCHITECTURE is the art and profession of designing buildings. It should rightly be opted by those with a creative bent of mind, by those, who have the ability to think beyond the mundane by simultaneously keeping the practical aspect in mind. There are numerous colleges all over India, that offer the B.Arch. (Bachelor in Architecture) Programme. After completing the 5 yr. course, a student may further choose to join the 2 yr. M.Arch. (Masters in Architecture) course from a college in India or abroad. Other than this, a graduate can immediately start working as an Architect after collecting the required practicing license from the COA (Council of Architecture). One can join a public or a private sector company to begin with and can gradually start freelancing for a flexible work schedule. It is also possible to be associated with a company on a particular project, simultaneously continuing with one's own practice. One can specialize in Interiors, or Landscaping, or Building services etc. or design a particular type of Building like Offices, or Residences, or Industries etc., the options are many. Teaching is another career option which can be managed well alongwith project-work.

We at NICS, prepare XI, XII studying and XII pass students for Architecture entrance examinations which entitle admission to 5 yr. B.Arch. programme in various colleges.

Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) Paper-2 is applicable for admission to various government colleges in Architecture (B.Arch) and Planning (B.Planning) all over India. It is conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA). The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India, has established NTA as an independent autonomous and self-sustained premier testing organization to assess the competency of candidates for admissions to premier higher education institutions.

For the first time in 2019, B.Arch JEE (Paper-2) was conducted twice thereby giving more opportunity to the students to improve their scores in the second attempt. Same is being done in 2025. However, appearing in both the tests is not compulsory. The student's best of the two NTA scores will be considered for preparation of Merit List/ Ranking.

**Note:** For students opting for both B.Arch. & B.Planning paper, a Planning based Objective Type Aptitude paper will also be conducted in CBT/Online mode for 30 minutes, totalling the exam duration for B.Arch. & B.Planning examination to 3hours and 30 minutes. There will be total of 25 MCQs in the Planning paper.

#### Method of Resolving ties

Tie between candidates obtaining equal Total NTA scores in B.Arch. will be resolved in the following manner:

- NTA score in Mathematics, followed by
- NTA score in Aptitude Test, followed by
- NTA score in Drawing Test, followed by
- Candidates with less proportion of negative responses and more...

#### Eligibility criteria for appearing in B.Arch. JEE (Paper-2) in 2025

- 1) Only those candidates who have passed their Class 12<sup>th</sup> examination in 2023 or 2024, or those who are appearing in their Class 12<sup>th</sup> examination in 2025 are eligible to appear in both January'25 and April'25 JEE-2025 Examination.
- Candidates must have taken at least five subjects in class 12th with Physics, Chemistry and Maths as compulsory subjects.
- 3) A diploma recognized by AICTE or a State board of technical education of at least 3 years duration with Mathematics as a compulsory subject.
- 4) For **B. Planning**, the candidates should have passed the qualifying examination with **50% marks** in **Mathematics** and **50% marks** in aggregate of the qualifying examination.

### **Admission Criteria**

- 1) Candidates should have secured 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Maths and also 75% marks in aggregate of the Class 12<sup>th</sup> examination.
- 2) Diploma candidates should have passed the 10+3 Diploma Examination with at least 50% marks in aggregate.
- 3) Admission will be based on All India Rank in B.Arch. JEE (Paper-2). There shall be no weightage for class 12th marks in preparation of Merit List/Ranking.

National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) is applicable for admission to various government and private colleges in Architecture (B.Arch.) all over India. It is conducted by Council of Architecture (COA) since 2006. The Council of Architecture, constituted by the Government of India is vested with the responsibility of maintaining the register of architects on national basis as well as regulating the Architecture education and practice of Architecture profession throughout India.

NATA measures the aptitude of the applicant for specific field of study, i.e., Architecture, through assessment of cognitive skills, visual perception and aesthetic sensitivity tests, logical reasoning and critical thinking ability, etc., besides the learning that the candidate has acquired over the past years.

With the objective of giving opportunities to a greater number of bright aspirants to join Architecture, Council will be conducting NATA-2024 for admission to B.Arch., in the academic year 2024 - 2025 on all weekends in two sessions starting from April to July, 2024.

#### SCHEDULE OF EXAMINATION

The candidates can appear for maximum of 3 attempts in NATA 2024 in one academic year. The best score out of all the attempts shall be considered for declaration of results. The score of NATA Test would be valid for a period of 2 academic years.

Examination shall be conducted on all weekends starting from April to July, 2024 in two sessions, subject to number of candidates registered for the session. The candidates need to indicate their preference for session & city of examination while registering at NATA portal www.nata. in. The session during which the candidate will take the test as well as the Test Centres, shall be allotted by the Council, as far as possible, on the basis of cities and sessions preferred by the candidate in the application form. However, the decision of the Council in allotting Test Centre and session to candidates shall be final.


